Enrolment

1. Please complete the ENROLMENT FORM and attach a PHOTOGRAPH if you have one available.
2. Enclose £200 as a deposit or instruct your bank to make a transfer of £200 to the Cambridge Academy of English account (see below).
3. Send the completed enrolment form to: **Ann Stevenson - Registrar,

4. As soon as your enrolment form and deposit have reached the Cambridge Academy, we will **immediately** send you your certificate of enrolment for your course, **or return the deposit, if the course is not available.**
5. When you have been admitted to a course, the £200 deposit is non-returnable, but is deducted from your course fees.

Payment

- Payment can be made by:
 1. Cheques in £ Sterling drawn on a bank in the UK.
 2. Card. All card transactions are charged at 2%, except for UK bank debit cards, which are free.

Cancellation

- 2 weeks or more before the booked period of study begins: fees refunded (except £200 deposit).
- Less than 2 weeks before the booked period of study begins: 50% refund.
- No refund can be made for late arrival, early departure, or missing part of a booked period of study.
- The Cambridge Academy of English reserves the right to exclude any student whose attendance is unsatisfactory or whose behaviour is disruptive. In such cases any refund of fees will be at CAE's discretion.

Insurance Cover

Visitors to Britain are normally given free accident/emergency treatment. However, we advise all students to take out insurance cover in their own country against loss of or damage to possessions, course cancellation after arrival in the UK through injury or illness, and the cost of urgent medical treatment. Insurance is automatically included in the fees for Academic Year students (ie staying 24 weeks or more).
